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BRAZILIAN AIR FORCE AWARDS FSS BRASIL CONTRACT FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF DEBRIEFING STATIONS FOR AIRCRAFT F-5BR AND A-29 SUPER TUCANO



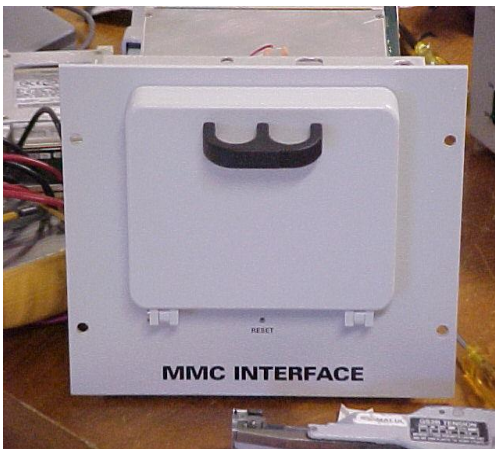
Vinhedo - SP, Brazil – FSS Brasil, a partner of COMPRO Computer Services Inc. for Brazil and the Latin America, and the Brazilian Air Force, through the team at the Advanced Computing Center, signed this morning the maintenance and Contractor Logistics Support (CLS) agreement for the stations that support the mission of its F-5BR and A-29 Super Tucano fleets. The debriefing stations allows the pilots to carry out a review of the flown mission, verifying the successes and flaws comparing to the mission plan.

There are 30 stations distributed among 8 different locations: Natal, RN; Boa Vista, RR; Porto Velho, RO; Campo Grande, MS; Rio de Janeiro - RJ; Canoas, RS; Annapolis, GO; and the Air Force Academy, in Pirassununga, SP.

The stations were originally developed by another company, and present major challenges for their maintenance, considering the advanced age and characteristics in the development of their software that make their maintenance unfeasible.

For these reasons, and to mitigate current performance and availability problems of stations caused by the accentuated obsolescence of the systems, FSS Brasil included in its scope the modernization of the equipment, with the complete replacement of the outdated software system and the revision of the hardware of both their computers and the cartridge reading units, modernizing both and, even so, maintaining the compatibility with previous standards.

All the technology used for the modernization will be developed by FSS Brasil, which maintains a work of continuous evolution of solutions and support teams in the southeast and north regions of the country, serving CLS contracts in Brazil and abroad.



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
